Who are we looking for?

We are seeking a highly motivated landscape management graduate or other appropriate qualification (countryside, estates, geography, environmental), who is either recently graduated or has some industry experience; to join our ambitious Land Management team of over 30 land management professionals.

Based in either our Gateshead or Market Harborough office the role is suitable for office or 'hybrid working' with time spent working from home in addition to attending our offices.

The role requires travel to and from site across the Midlands or North East, and a valid full UK driving licence is essential.

Our Land Management service is well established and has always been a core part of our business.

Role and Requirements

The successful applicant will provide a supporting role as part of a multi-disciplinary team delivering Land Management projects, primarily for Homes England. Our Land Management team play a critical role in the delivery of the Homes England Estate Management Services Framework.

Homes England is responsible for an extensive and diverse portfolio of land across England. Sites range from greenfield land; woodlands; brownfield land; and derelict building complexes such as former hospitals. The role will include regular site visits to assess, identify, record and mitigate hazards, record signage, identify encroachment, support the management of maintenance contracts, and procuring and monitoring works identified through the site inspections. All issues identified on site are recorded using bespoke management software, developed on behalf of Homes England.

As a Graduate Landscape and Estates Manager you will be welcomed into our friendly and supportive team and develop skills in:

- Landscape and estates management;
- Health and safety management;
- Contract procurement and administration;
- Invasive non-native species; and
- Landscape audits.

The successful candidate will be expected to travel to sites, including staying overnight at different locations from time to time, to meet the requirements of projects.

- Understanding of landscape maintenance contracts, management of contractors and procurement processes.
