The Opportunity

Who are we looking for?

TEP is looking for surveyors with a range of backgrounds from recent graduates through to experienced and licensed ecologists.

Opportunities are available to join us on either a freelance or fixed-term contract basis from Spring to Autumn 2025. Candidates are invited to apply for either one or both of these positions. Freelance ecologists will work primarily on protected species nocturnal surveys and fixed term ecologists will gain experience working in the office environment alongside nocturnal survey work.

Significant Training and on the job support and mentoring will be provided to ensure all surveyors are working to TEP and industry standards. For freelance ecologists, work is paid at an hourly rate and approved expenses reimbursed.

Travel at times of day and to locations where public transport is unavailable means a valid UK driving licence and access to a car is vital for the role. The work may necessitate travel throughout the UK and overnight stays. The following paragraphs provide further information on likely survey work.

Role and Requirements

Freelance Ecologists

Primarily undertaking nocturnal protected species surveys for great crested newt or bats. Surveys involve work at night and early mornings (dawn surveys) and can involve substantial walking and carrying heavy or bulky equipment.

Daytime assistance may also be required for our amphibian mitigation schemes, where a daily presence (including weekends) is required, to inspect traps and translocate amphibians.

Fixed Term Ecologists

Fixed-term ecologists will also undertake nocturnal protected species surveys and amphibian translocation. In addition, there will be daytime survey work where lone working is not appropriate. This includes working in water (otter and water vole surveys), working at height (bat inspections) and working in very remote locations.

Fixed-term ecologists will also work in the office environment supporting TEP ecologists with desk-based studies, compilation of survey data and basic report writing. Full training will be provided through our internal training academy.

Selection Day

The Selection Day will be held on Friday 10th January 2025 at Warrington. Following the Selection Day we will invite successful candidates to join our team either on a fixed-term contract or on a freelance basis to work with us from Spring to Autumn 2025 with the potential of permanent work following that.


